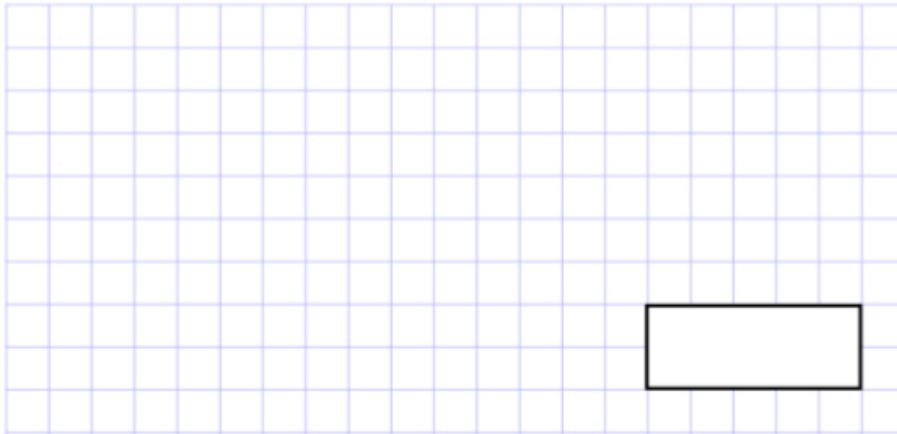

$$468 - 70 = 398$$

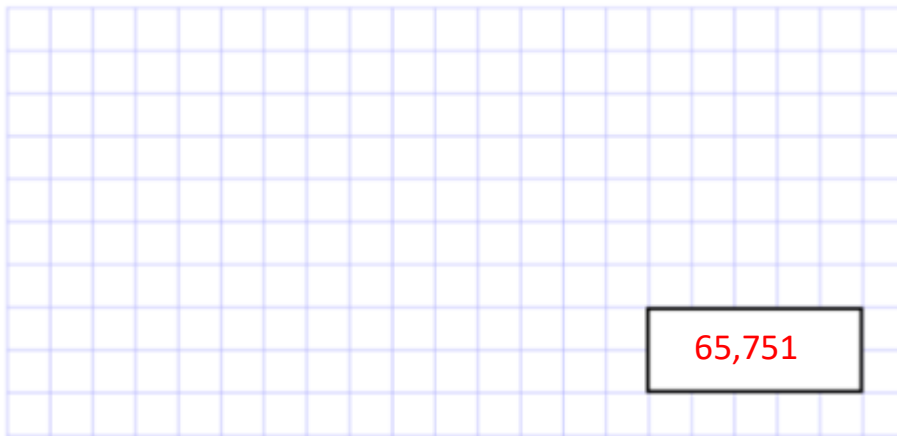
398 people watch the movie.
